PART 1: ORDINANCE 1

CONSTRUCTION OF THE BOOK OF ORDINANCES

SECTION 1: Short Title.

This collection of Ordinances shall be known and may be cited as the "Lenox Township Book of Ordinances".

SECTION 2: Amendments/Additions to the Book of Ordinances.

Upon adoption of the Lenox Township Book of Ordinances (Book), all new Ordinances shall be numbered and formatted in a manner consistent with this Book, unless the Township Board otherwise determines that another format is more beneficial for Township purposes. The Ordinance structure or hierarchy may be referenced or cited for amendments or additions as indicated in the following examples:

Addition Example 1:

Ordinance __ (Insert Ordinance Title) is hereby added to Part __ (Insert Part Title) of the Lenox Township Book of Ordinances and shall read as follows:

"INSERT NEW ORDINANCE"

Addition Example 2:

Subsection __ (Insert Subsection Title, if any) is hereby added to Part __ (Insert Part Title), Ordinance __ (Insert Ordinance Title), Section __ (Insert Section Title, if any) of the Lenox Township Book of Ordinances as follows:

"INSERT NEW SUBSECTION"

Amendment Example:

Part __ (Insert Part Title), Ordinance __ (Insert Ordinance Title), Section __ (Insert Section Title, if any), Subsection __ (Insert Subsection Title, if any), Subsection __ (Insert Subsection Title, if any) of the Lenox Township Book of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

"INSERT AMENDED TEXT"

SECTION 3: Repeals.

- A. Parts, Ordinances, Sections and Subsections may be repealed by citing the appropriate division of the Book of Ordinances.

Example:

Part __ (Insert Part Title), Ordinance __ (Insert Ordinance Title), Section __ (Insert Section Title, if any), Subsection __ (Insert Subsection Title, if any) of the Lenox Township Book of Ordinances is hereby repealed.

- B. Repealing an ordinance, or part thereof, that included the repeal of a separate ordinance, or part thereof, shall not have the effect of revalidating the previously repealed ordinance.

SECTION 4: References / Citations / Clarifications.

In cases where a reference, citation or interpretation to an Ordinance, Section, or Subsection is determined to be unclear, incorrect or inaccurate, the originally adopted ordinance shall be utilized to determine such meaning or citation.

SECTION 5: Omissions.

Ordinances omitted from this Book of Ordinances, whether accidentally or intentionally, shall remain valid and enforceable, as legally adopted.
